**Eligible participants who are not CTF members can qualify prior to participation in one of two ways:
a) by paying the appropriate affiliated membership dues (\$24.00 Canadian) or b) by paying a participation fee (\$5.00 Canadian)**

Rules - General:

- 1) All CTF rules not specified here will be in effect.
- 2) All bowlers are required to be CTF Sanctioned.
- 3) Any bowler entering the tournament who is not eligible as to CTF sanction shall forfeit any claims to refunds and/or prize money, and all associated scores of said bowler shall be disqualified.
- 4) Prizes: 1 prize for every 10 entries. All prize fees will be returned 100%.
- 5) Canadian money orders or bank cheques will be the only form of reserving your spot in advance. (Post dated cheques not accepted). Walk-ins must pay by money, Canadian money orders or cash. (Cheques not accepted)
- 6) Positively no refunds. In case of absence or inability to bowl, you may substitute.

Bowler Eligibility:

- 7) TEAM: Any 4 CTF bowlers may form a team subject to the following:
 - A) Men's and Women's events are open division.
 - B) Mixed teams can consist of any combination of 4 bowlers but have a minimum of at least one woman & 3 men or 1 man & 3 women bowlers.
 - C) No more than 1 first year bowler may bowl on the same 4 person team.

Doubles and Singles:

- 8) Two first year bowlers are not allowed to bowl together in Doubles.
- 9) Touring Professional Bowlers are not allowed to participate. (see definitions)
- 10) Bowlers under the age of 18 must furnish the tournament with signed parental consent.

Averages:

- 11) All bowlers will use their Highest USBC/CTF sanctioned average in the past three seasons (2007-2008, 2008-2009 and 2009-2010) minimum of 21 games. Current season average used will be at the time of bowling. (Minimum of 21 games) Collegiate, YABA, summer league, and unsanctioned league averages are not acceptable averages for entry, but must be reported prior to bowling. It is each bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, team captain, or other. In addition:
 - A) Any bowler without a sanctioned average from either of the past 2 seasons (2008-2009, 2009-2010) must bowl scratch.
 - B) TEAM: At least 3 bowlers must have a 2009-2010 sanctioned average. At least 3 bowler must have 2 consecutive sanctioned averages in the past 3 seasons. Failing this your team will bowl scratch.
 - C) Doubles: At least 1 bowler must have a 2008-2009 sanctioned average. At least 1 bowler must have 2 consecutive sanctioned averages in the past 3 seasons. If not both bowlers bowl scratch.
 - D) Rule 319A - 2 applies.
 - E) If any reported average is from a Tough Shot or Sport League, it must be reported as such use of this average may be denied.
- 12) Use of current season average prior to either the end of the league season or the date that averages are submitted to your local association, requires that notarized verification of average is to be submitted by the last day of the tournament if not at time of bowling.
- 13) Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify your score if the submitted average is lower than your correct average thereby resulting in allowed classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series. (Rule 319a-3)
- 14) Tournament Management has the right to adjust scores after bowling should verified average or other pertinent information become available that was not available at the time of check-in.
- 15) The maximum average of handicap in this tournament is 220 for Singles, 440 for Doubles, and 880 for Teams. You may bowl should you exceed the maximums in each event, but will receive a zero handicap.
- 16) The team captains signature on the application verifies all information to be correct as submitted.

Average Adjustment:

- 17) All entrants are required to be familiar with CTF Rule 319E re-rating requirements and comply with all requirements in each separate event. The tournament has the right to adjust, reject or reclassify any entry without penalty prior to the time of bowling in each separate event. (See rule #19)
- 18) Entry fee will be refunded if entrant(s) do not wish to participate after being notified of any adjustment. Only the doubles set or team affected is eligible for refund.

Handicap:

- 19) In all events the handicap will be based on 90% of the difference of the total average and maximum average allowed in each event listed in rule #14.

Declaration:

- 20) All bowlers are required to report at the time of registration:
 - A) All prize winnings of \$500 or more in a sanctioned or unsanctioned event from the previous 36 months prior to each separate event.
 - B) Any current top 10 position in any event (sanctioned or non-sanctioned)
 - C) Any re-rate or average adjustment in the past 3 years, whether accepted or refused, and/or disqualified by any tournament sanctioned or not.
- 21) Bowlers who fail to report any of the above prior to bowling may be disqualified, forfeiting all tournament fees and winnings.

Tournament Play:

- 22) All bowlers must report to the tournament office one hour before their scheduled bowling time to check in and draw for lanes. Walk-ins are allowed. All Doubles partners must check in together. The tournament office will assign lanes for late arriving bowlers.
- 23) The tournament office will try to even up all squads, In the event of circumstances beyond control bowlers who draw lanes alone must bowl alone. Upon refusing to do so no entry monies will be refunded.
- 24) All games in each event will be bowled on the same pair of lanes The order in which the bowlers are listed on the entry form will be the official bowling order. No changing or re-arranging of bowlers will be allowed.
- 25) A bowler or bowlers arriving late will be allowed to bowl, however scoring will start with the frame in which they are ready to bowl.
- 26) Substitutions will be allowed. All substitution s must be reported to the tournament office at least one hour prior to bowling.
- 27) When a substitute enters an event already in progress (not allowed in singles) the handicap will be based on the original bowlers average or the substitutes average which ever on is higher.
- 28) All claims of error in scoring must be made to a tournament official immediately. No changes in score will be made after the next bowler bowls.
- 29) In the case of an automatic pinsetter or scorer breakdown the tournament officials have the right to move bowlers to other lanes. If lanes are not available whatever steps necessary to continue play will be utilized.
- 30) Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, national emergency, or emergencies related to strikes, labour difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of Cataract Bowl shall cause the forgoing prize list to be prorated in accordance to the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events at the time of termination.

Multiple Participation:

- 31) A bowler may compete as many times as they want in each event but may cash only once in the singles with their highest score, in the doubles you may cash only once with the same partner with your highest score, but may cash each time you bowl if you change partners, and in the teams you can cash only once with the same 4 bowlers, but may cash each time you bowl if your team changes at lease one bowler. (Each bowler's first appearance in each event shall count towards their all events total CTF rule 317)

Closing Date for Entries: All entries will close with the start of the final shift of the tournament.

Definitions:

First year bowler: A bowler who has never had a sanctioned average in an adult league prior to the 2008-2009 season, or has not had a sanctioned average in any of the past 5 bowling seasons.

Touring Professional Bowler: Any member that is in the top 50 of the money winners list in the PBA or top ten in the PWBA as of March 1, 2009.

Failure to abide by any of the above rules may result in your disqualification.
